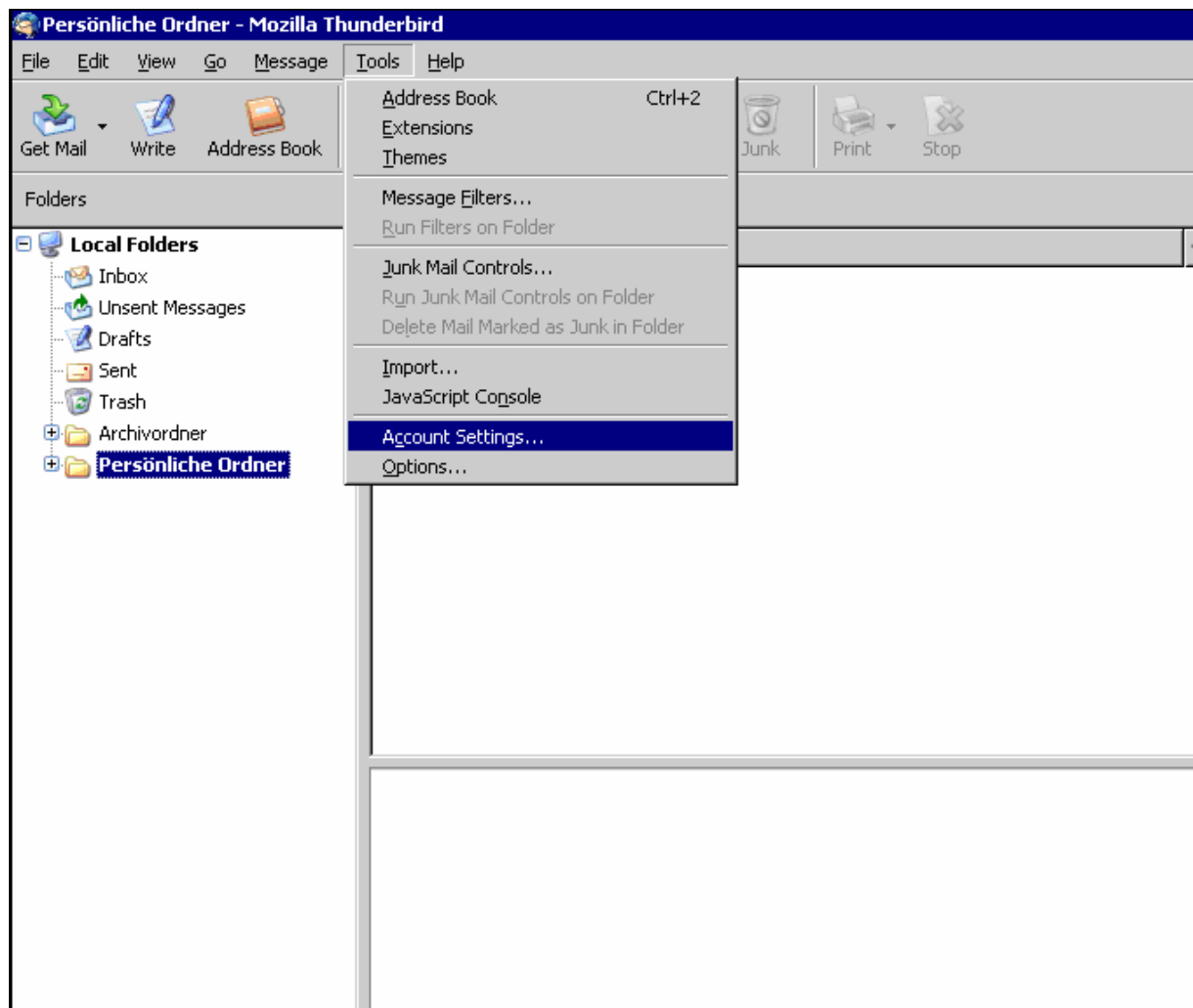

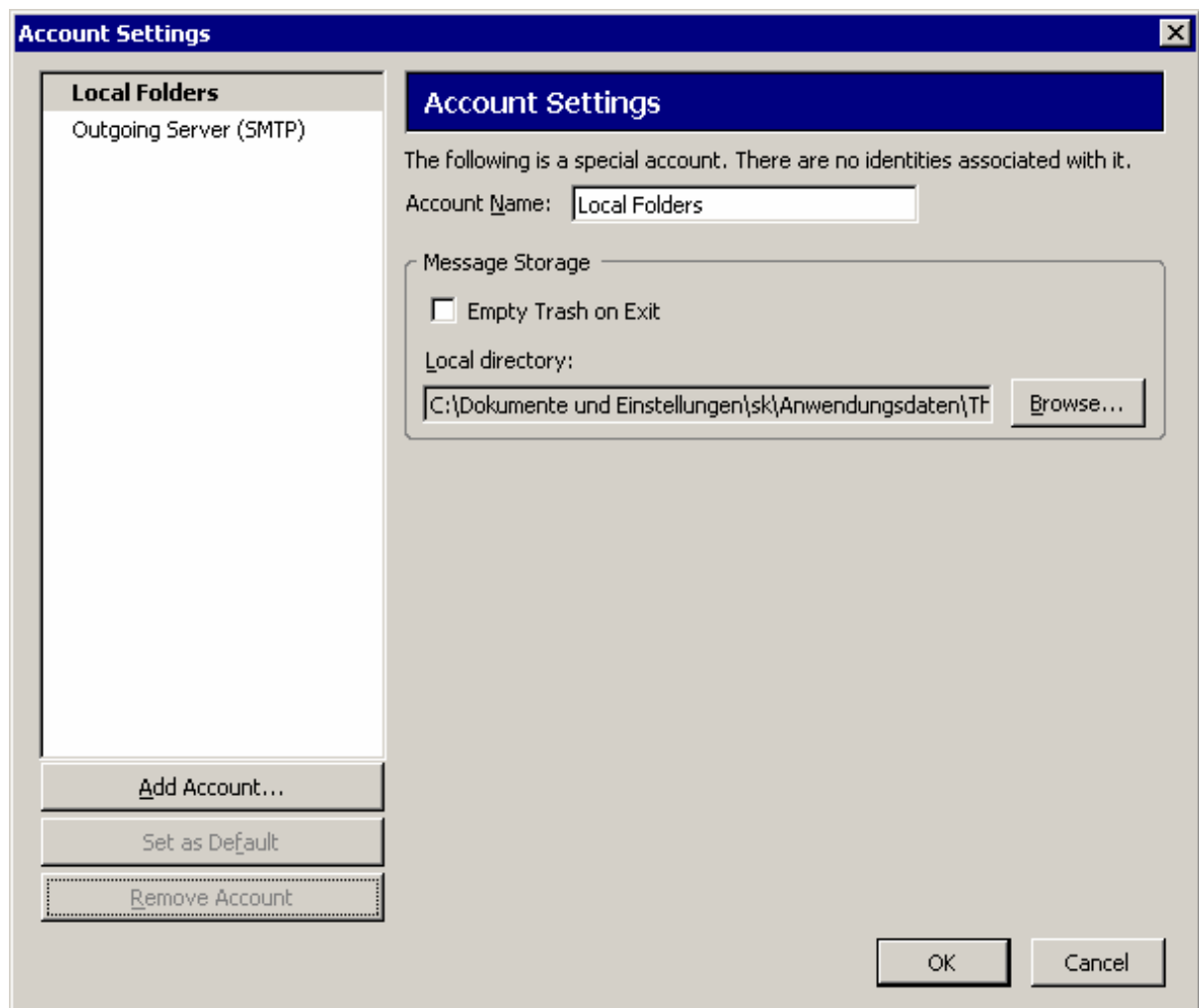


1. Mozilla öffnen
